























CONTOUR PLAN OF ROUNDABOUT


VIEW POINT NO.21 MODEL VIEW FROM ROAD D4



We record below the salient points that were discussed during the above inspection:-

- 1. Further to the pre-handover inspection held previously amongst HMJV, ARUP, CRBC and VUJV on 31 December 2019, we record that it was requested from VUJV that all the paving blocks had to be completed on or before the handover of the site areas.
- 2. A site inspection was conducted amongst HMJV, ARUP, CRBC and VUJV for the area in green as shown in Annex I. A list of outstanding works is included in Annex II and CRBC agreed to complete the outstanding works as per dates as stated on the list.

3. As discussed previously, ARUP/VUJV acknowledged that the soft landscape works within the areas in both green and yellow colours that would be affected by their works would be taken up by them and they would be responsible to hand over the soft landscape works to LCSD subsequently. The extent of the soft landscape works to be taken up by EMSD Contract No. 2852EM17A would be further agreed after the meeting. In addition, ARUP requested HMJV to provide the latest drawings in related to the concerned soft landscape works for their information.

[Post Meeting Notes: ARUP confirmed that the extent of the remaining soft landscape works that would be constructed under EMSD Contract No. 2852EM17A as shown in Annex I. The latest drawings in related to the concerned soft landscape works is attached in Annex IV.]

4. CRBC stated that three street light posts within the areas in both green and yellow colours would be installed by HyD/Lighting in the future and reminded VUJV to coordinate with HyD/Lighting and allow access for installation. VUJV agreed and requested CRBC to provide the locations of the street light posts for their site arrangement to avoid their plants and equipment sitting on those areas as far as possible.

[Post Meeting Notes: The location of the proposed street light posts is shown on the site sketch in Annex I. In addition, it was agreed that the proposed location of the street light post HL-04 shall be further coordinated with HyD/Lighting by HMJV for relocation to avoid any physical conflict with EMSD's jacking pit.]

- 5. Besides the outstanding works mentioned in bullets 2, 3 and 4 above, there were no outstanding works and defects identified during the inspections. ARUP and VUJV expressed no adverse comment on the condition of the site area (Green) during the inspection. It was agreed that the site area (Green) was handed over to EMSD Contract No. 2852EM17A on 10 January 2020 whereas the site area (Yellow) had been handed over on 12 August 2019.
- 6. HMJV recalled the agreement made on 7 March 2019 (Annex III), the sections of footpath, planter (hard landscape works) and carriageway within the areas in both green and yellow colours handed over to EMSD Contract No. 2852EM17A would be reinstated and handed over to the maintenance department, i.e. HyD, by EMSD Contract No. 2852EM17A upon the completion of DCS works. HMJV will provide all as-built drawings and relevant test results to ARUP as stipulated in Item 4 of the email dated 7 March 2019 (Annex III).

- 7. HMJV recalled the agreement made on 7 March 2019 (Annex III), EMSD Contract No. 2852EM17A should maintain a footpath within the areas in both green and yellow colours after CRBC completed all their works and removed all TTA. VUJV requested HMJV/CRBC to provide at least one month notification before CRBC completed all their works and removed all TTA such that they could arrange the necessary TTA to maintain the footpath.
- 8. For safety, CRBC would provide road barriers at the planter areas they are working on until their works are completed.
- 9. HMJV would provide the coordinates of the blank flanges left for the DCS connection.


