

ESB- 349/2021	30 August 2024	27 September 2024	<ul> <li>The proposed changes in the scope of the Project are indicated in Figure 1 as set out below:</li> <li>(i) revised layout of anchorage rearrangement at Kellett Bank <ul> <li>northern end of the boundary of the rearrangement works is shifted northward by about 570 m</li> <li>dredging area will be reduced from about 430 hectares (ha) to about 165 ha</li> <li>dredging volume will be reduced from about 17.1 million m<sup>3</sup> to about 9.6 million m<sup>3</sup></li> </ul> </li> <li>(ii) removal of a construction access</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Nature of works remains unchanged.</li> <li>Types of habitats included in the environmental impact assessment remain unchanged.</li> <li>Assessment area of the applicable impact assessments in the EIA study had been adjusted according to the revised boundary of the anchorage rearrangement works.</li> <li>No additional environmental issues associated with the proposed changes of the scope of the Project.</li> <li>Scope of issues covered by the issued EIA-SB can still cover the proposed changes in the scope of the Project.</li> <li>The proposed changes in the scope of the Project would not fundamentally alter the scope of issues covered by the issued EIA-SB.</li> <li>On the above basis, a fresh EIA-SB for the Project with the revised Project scope is not required.</li> </ul>
