

- Maintain agriculture lands for multiple benefit (ie habitat/landscape)
- · Manage fisheries to rebuild over time
- · Expand food safety testing

Unmitigated Responses

- Development of agricultural land in HK
- Loss of critical fish habitat to development
- Competition from imports Impacts of pollution on production/markets (real or perceived)
- Extreme fishing pressure on fish stocks

Agriculture and Fisheries

- Loss of agricultural land and associated habitat/landscape benefits
- Continued low value fishery or collapse of stocks
- Health impacts on population (eg pesticides)
- Further erosion of self sufficiency in food production
