

- · Implement an explicit conservation policy
- Recognise and minimise the effects of pollutants on threatened species
- Coordinate management of threatened species on a regional basis
- · Restoration of habitats

Unmitigated Responses

- Development of natural areas for housing, transport and services
- Recreation and other human usage of natural areas (⇒ habitat disturbance, hill fires, dumping)
- Fragmentation of undisturbed habitat
- Pollution and poaching effects on species

Terrestrial Habitats and Species

- Incremental damage to critical habitat which are necessary to vulnerable organisms
- · Loss of terrestrial biodiversity
- Disappearance of rare and endangered species and disruption of the ecosystem
